

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#### MIDWEST CLOWN ASSOCIATION Bill "Bibo" Young Memorial Registration Scholarship Program Description/Guidelines

#### ESTABLISHMENT:

The Midwest Clown Association (MCA) Registration Scholarship Program was established by a unanimous vote of Member Alley Representatives at the Spring Membership Meeting on May 6, 2023.

#### **PURPOSE:**

In the wake of the pandemic, as hotel and registration costs increased and attendance at annual clown gatherings decreased, the scholarship program was established to provide financial assistance to individuals wishing to attend the Annual MCA Round-up.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

The Scholarship Program is available to:

- Any clown living in one of the seven MCA defined states of: Minnesota, Iowa, Wisconsin, Illinois, Michigan, Indiana, and/or Ohio.
- Any clown that is a member of an active alley in good standing (defined as current with annual dues) that is based in one of the above states, but lives outside the Midwest and is in good standing with the Alley to which they belong.

#### NAME:

The Midwest Clown Association Registration Scholarship shall be known as the Bill "BIBO" Young Memorial Registration Scholarship in honor of the years of service and dedication that Bill provided to the MCA and his devotion to the art of clowning.

#### AMOUNT:

A minimum of two (2) scholarships will be awarded annually, contingent upon the amount of monies raised by the annual MCA Auction held during the Annual MCA Round-up. The amount of the scholarship shall be equal to one half the annual registration fee set by the hosting alley or Board. The Scholarship will be for one half the amount of which the "Early Bird" registration was initialized.

#### TIMELINE:

Determination of the amount of the scholarship (registration fee) and the number of scholarships shall be determined at the MCA Fall Meeting following the annual Auction of the year prior. (At the Fall General Meeting it was announced that 5 Scholarships will be awarded in 2024.) Deadline for application shall be no later than **April 1st** of that year's Round-up. Scholarship recipients shall be announced at the Spring Meeting. The Scholarship Committee will notify the MCA Executive Board and hosting Alley with the names of the recipients so funds may be distributed to cover the registration fees.

#### **REQUIREMENTS OF RECIPIENTS:**

- Scholarship recipients shall be required to register for the upcoming Annual MCA Round-up by August 31, so that the scholarship can be applied to their registration fee.
- Recipients shall be required to write an article for the MCA 3 Ring News within 6 months of attending the Round-up detailing their experience at the Round Up and what they learned.
- Anyone who has been a recipient of the Bill "BIBO" Young scholarship will not be eligible to submit another scholarship application for 3 years.

#### **SELECTION PROCESS:**

Scholarships shall be awarded by the Scholarship Committee (designated by the Chief Joey). The Scholarship Committee shall utilize the following criteria for selection:

- Timeliness of application (April 1st deadline as determined by date of postmark or date of being received by email by the designated recipient).
- Thoroughness of the application process (was it complete?)
- Essay on the application detailing why the applicant would like to attend to the Annual Round-up and what they hope to learn or gain from the experience.
- Note: Priority may be given to those individuals who are first-time Round-Up attendees, in order to encourage new members, as long as all criteria are met.

#### Midwest Clown Association Registration Payment Plan Information and Agreement

Your MCA Board knows times are tough all 'round for the entertainment/performance industry. And we also have felt the "pinch" of increased costs from the hospitality industry hosting the last two years of our annual conference. After careful consideration, and to be good stewards of our dues and MCA organization, we have made the hard decision to raise registration fees for the annual Round-Up in order to make ends meet, and not deplete the organization's entire General Fund supplementing the conference. We had already transitioned to ZOOM Spring meetings to cut down on travel costs for our board members and alley representatives, and many of our host committee members "supplemented" items we would normally pay for out of registrations. But we must be frugal going forward, and although it's painful to increase registration rates, we have to do so in order to make ends meet. BUT...with that being said, again, this year, we are offering a payment plan for registrations. That way, you can pay a downpayment to get one of the early registration rates, and pay it off in installments, while still maintaining that earlier discounted rate.

#### **HERE'S HOW IT WORKS:**

- Check the box on your registration form that says "Check here if you're taking advantage of payment program." (Yellow box in lower right hand corner of registration.)
- Pay \$70 as a downpayment toward the total registration amount at time of registration.
- You can send it in the mail to the Registrar or there is a Downpayment box to check online to pay the designated amount (remember a small processing fee will be added if paying online).
- Fill out the form below and return it via e-mail (angela.gonzalez@indy.gov) or regular mail to Angie Gonzalez, 8419 Bermuda Drive, Indianapolis, IN 46219.
- You will be contacted by Angie to set up payments and will be instructed where to send the remaining payment checks or how to make payments with a credit/debit card online via PayPal.
- Your registration must be fully paid within one month of the start of the Round-Up. Your downpayment is non-refundable in the event you must cancel, unless faced with an uncontrollable emergency before the cancellation cut-off date.
